Louisiana State Police Explosives License Application Process

1. Fill out Explosives Application completely. Sign application. **All fees are non-refundable.**
2. Attach two complete, legible, and classifiable FBI Applicant Fingerprint Cards. Cards must be taken by a person employed by a law enforcement agency trained in recording fingerprints. Also attach a copy of applicant's training certificate. **Remember, only courses and instructors approved by State Police will be accepted.**
3. Once the application is received into our office, the background process will start. If the application is denied, the company will still receive a denial letter. **All fees are non-refundable.**
4. If the application is approved, the company representative listed on the application will be contacted by State Police. The applicant will then have a choice of coming to Headquarters in Baton Rouge or going to one of the troop locations on the assigned dates in order to take their photo for their explosives license. All applicants will be required to bring a current driver's license or official ID card with them when they come for their photo.

Applicants who come to Baton Rouge for their photos will receive their photo explosives licenses that day, and will receive their paper licenses through the mail. Applicants whose pictures are taken at the troop locations will receive their explosives photo licenses and paper licenses through the mail.

You must have your Louisiana Explosives Photo License in order to work. The only exceptions are current license holders whose licenses expire in 2009. These license holders must have a copy of their paper license on them in order to work.
