## Course Description

Craigslist is more than a “classifieds” section on the internet, from humble beginnings it has grown into one of the largest online marketplaces. This course is designed to help agencies get in front of the online technology curve by learning what Craigslist is, how to use it in police investigations, and learn what is coming next for online criminal activity. It will explain how Craigslist grew and expanded into a full-fledged internet site offering lists for jobs, entertainment, and services. Expanding across the United States and abroad, in 2010 Craigslist served nearly 600 cities in more than 50 countries. But people aren’t just buying and selling old bicycles and furniture. With thousands of people interacting and millions of dollars being transferred, criminal activity is certain to appear.
